Subject: Fair Financial Reports – December 2023

Enclosed are the Fair financial reports for the #218 County Fair Fund and #224 Capital Project

Fund for December 2023. The report includes revenues, expenditures year-to-date, and budget updates.

#### Fair Revenue & Expenditures

The first report includes the County Fair and Capital Project revenue and expenditure information

through December 2023.

The #218 County Fair fund highlights total revenue of \$379,069, or 81%, year-to-date. The revenue for December includes the Rent of the Building and Grounds, \$1,680; Donations, \$0; and a budgeted transfer from transient room tax, \$16,395.

The total expenditures are \$12,661 for December, broken out between personnel, \$1260 or 10%;

materials and services, \$10,734 or 85%; and budgeted transfer to #224 Capital Project Fund, \$667 or <5%

of the total monthly expenditures. Highlighting other expenditures are Repair and Maintenance for \$2478

and Utilities for \$4779. Overall, in December, materials and services were \$283,865 year-to-date, or 86% of budget.




