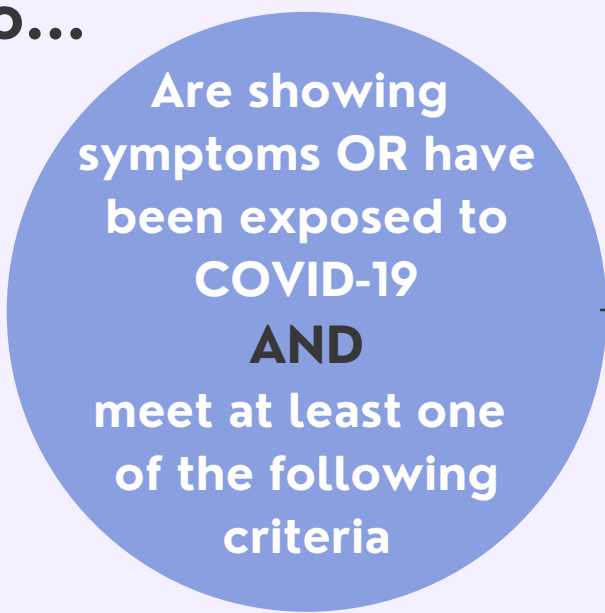






# OREGON IS CHANGING THE WAY WE FIGHT COVID-19.

Due to a national shortage of COVID-19 tests, Oregon Health Authority has released new testing guidelines. These guidelines help to make sure we have enough available tests for those most at-risk of severe COVID-19 symptoms.

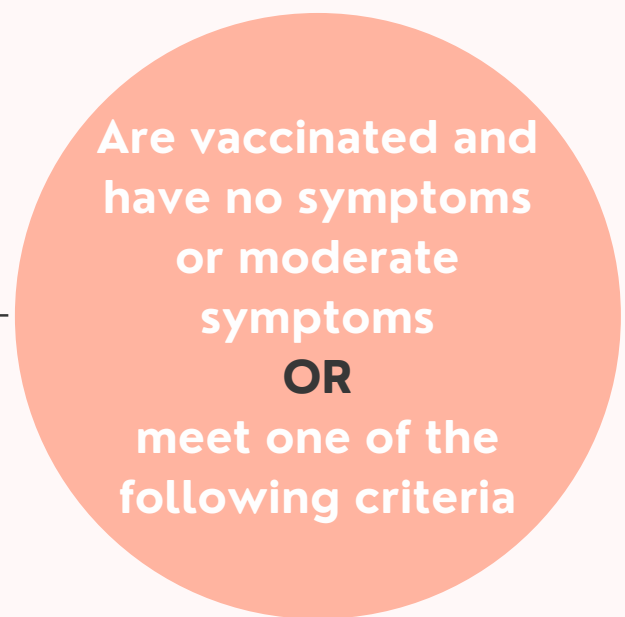
## JCPH is prioritizing testing for those who...



- Age 65 and over **65+**
- Serious underlying health conditions 
- Unvaccinated 
- Pregnant or parent of a newborn 
- Essential workers/first responders 

## JCPH suggests going to your provider to test if you...

-  Traveling
-  Work/school requires testing
-  Symptoms started less than 5 days ago
-  Exposed but no symptoms



Unfortunately, OHA guidelines do not permit JCPH to test individuals for work, school, or travel at this time. Check with your employer, school, or provider to see if they have tests available.

If you have been experiencing COVID-19 symptoms for less than 5 days, your COVID-19 test may not give accurate results. Please wait until at least 5 days to test, as this is likely to give the most accurate results.
