To: Media Release Re: Cattle Theft

The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office has taken three separate reports of cattle rustling occurring in the area surrounding Juniper Butte near Culver in rural SW Jefferson County. Each incident the victims reported unknown person(s) entered their property in the middle of the night and removed newborn baby calves.

The Oregon Department of Agriculture says that higher than normal beef prices have lead to an increase in cattle theft state wide, and warn ranchers to be extra vigilant in prevent rustling.

As many as 200 head of cattle are estimated to be stolen each year in the State of Oregon but many losses aren't reported to law enforcement. Sheriff Jim Adkins says these reports are the first his office has received and is seeking help from the public in identifying suspects. Sheriff Adkins said "any livestock theft is a felony," and my office will treat these incidents as high priority.
