Sprayer Share Check-out

Thanks to the **Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board grant**, backpack and hand sprayers are available for check-out to landowners in Jefferson County to treat noxious weeds. This pilot program encourages landowners to treat weeds on their own property and intended to benefit individuals that cannot afford to purchase a quality sprayer unit or landowners needing additional sprayers to treat large areas. This program is not intended for businesses.

To **check-out a backpack**(4.5 gallons) or **hand sprayer**(2 gallons), email the Weeds Coordinator at Jefferson County Public Works, tlaird@jeffco.net. Please provide your name, address, phone number and pick-up/drop-off dates. You may also print out this form. Sprayers may be checked-out for a two week period on a first-come, first-served basis.

Guidelines:

1. All operators of sprayers must read and understand the label of the product(s) being applied. Jefferson County is not liable for any type of misapplication under any circumstance due to user error, neglect, misunderstanding. Remember, the label is the law.
2. Jefferson County does not provide any herbicide or adjuvant with the sprayers.
3. Sprayers must be rinsed and completely emptied before returning to Public Works. Jefferson County does not assume chemical disposal responsibility.
